**Wildlife Rescue WIRES – Mid South Coast.**

This letter entitles the bearer to dispose of euthanised native animals for the WIRES - Mid-South Coast Branch within the Eurobodalla at the Brou Waste Management Facility and Surf Beach Waste Management Facility without payment of any fees until 30 June 2023.

Please note that all loads are to be weighed/recorded for Council waste audit requirements. Waste Management Facility staff are required to confirm the identity of bearer and source of waste material to ensure that only genuine Wildlife Rescue WIRES material is being received.

All recoverable and recyclable material must be separated prior to delivery and unloaded as directed by the weighbridge operator. This ensures that Council is maximising resource recovery and diverting all recyclable material away from landfill. Failure to separate recoverable and recyclable materials delivered to the waste facility may result in relevant tipping fees applied.

Under the *Local Government Act 1993* all Council policies are required to be reviewed and updated as required. Council will continue to provide financial assistance grants under the community grants policy including the provision of waste fee exemptions for charities and not for profit organisations. Please continue to contact Council on an annual basis where your application for an exemption of waste fees will be reviewed and you will be notified on an outcome.
